How to Confirm Pigs In & Move Pigs Out of Markets or Collection centres

It is now a legal requirement that all pig movements be recorded electronically.

To do electronic pig movement licences and confirmations you will first need to log onto www.eaml2.org.uk


You will then need to enter your user name & password on the registered user section and click login.



All movements need to be confirmed into the Collection Centre <u>Before</u> you should move pigs out


You will be presented with the screen that allows you to see ALL the movements on your market and collection centre services page **for the day** of the movement to enable you to confirm them in first as soon as you login

Use the search boxes to locate the farm by using 2 pieces of information, for best results use the holding number and postcode of the farm






