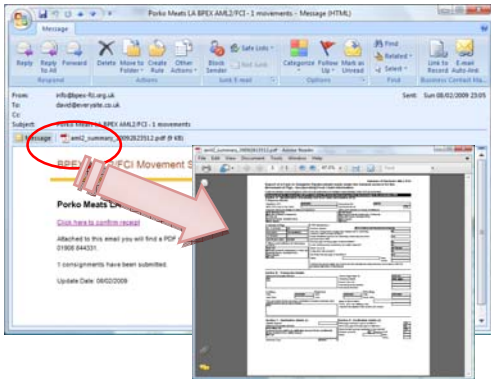


Your Local Authority eAML2 Services



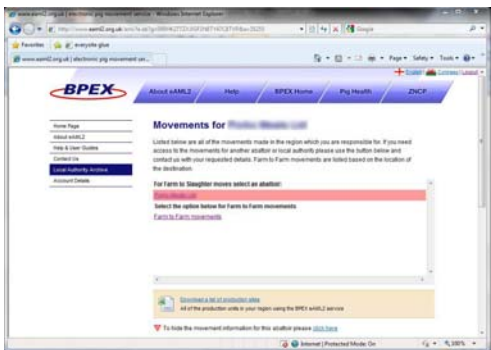
1. Your regular movement information emails

As a registered local authority you will start receiving regular electronic movement emails. The emails will be sent to you once the producer and abattoir has completed all the required movement information. The email will have a PDF attached containing all of the AML2 information. If you have any problem opening the attached files please visit: <http://get.adobe.com/uk/reader/> or contact your IT support




2. The movement information will be automatically submitted to AMLS by the BPEX service once both the source and destination have provided all of the required movement feedback.

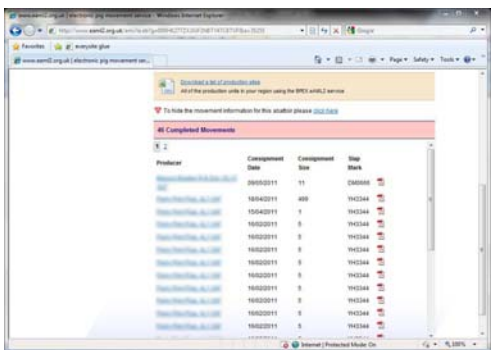
If you think any information is missing for a consignment you can phone the BPEX helpline on 0844 335 8400. If for any reason you do not receive an email or have deleted it by mistake you can access all of your information online in your eAML2 account.



3. Your online services

In addition to regular emails you can access an archive of all of your movements and view copies of reports at any time via the website

- Go to www.eaml2.org.uk
- Login using your username and password
- Click on "Local Authority Archive" on the left hand side
- To view the movements select an abattoir at the top of the page; the corresponding movements will appear in "Completed Movements". If you would like to print a copy of a movement, you can do so by clicking on the producer's name or pressing the  button in the list.
