

Notification of eAML2 Licensing Process Amendment

Please note, that after careful consideration and discussions with DEFRA and other industry bodies we will be amending the wording of one question in the eAML2 licencing process. This amendment will come into effect on the 3rd of March 2026. The amendment will simplify answering this question, reducing confusion when creating licences.

Current question:

Is the holding or area under restrictions for animal health or other reasons?

Revised question:

Are your pigs under restrictions for animal health or other reasons?

It is important to remember that if your pigs are under restriction by animal health or for any other reasons, you must ensure relevant paperwork (i.e. an exemption licence) accompanies your pigs with the haulier and eAML2 licence.

We will be adding a reminder to the help section next to the question on the online form so that this will be reminded of during licence creation.
